

NATHAN BALLARD VISITS VICTORY LANE TWICE AT HAWKEYE DOWNS

CALEB ADRIAN EARNS THIRD LATE MODEL WIN

(Cedar Rapids, IA 07/11/015)—Nathan Ballard scored feature wins in both Barron Motor Supply Hobby Stocks and Mountain Dew Sportsmen at Hawkeye Downs Speedway Friday night during Croell Redi-Mix Night brought to you by Electronics Engineering.

Dallas Chandler kicked off the night taking home the victory hardware in Miller Time Hornets and earning his third win of the season. The victory didn't come easy however as Chandler had to make a tire change during a lap three caution and start at the tail of the field.

Todd Ness led until lap eight when Derek Parrott grabbed the point but Chandler quickly worked through the field and ran away with the race as the final laps tickewd off. Parrott finished second and Ness was third.

As has been the case much of the year, Nathan Ballard needed just a couple laps to go from last to first in the Barron Motor Supply Hobby Stock feature. His run to the checkers was interrupted for a couple cautions but each time he pulled away on route to his seventh win of the season. Kevin franks posted an impressive run, finishing second in a car normally piloted by Gerald Hall. Jason Sherman posted a third place run to keep pace with point leader Nathan Ballard.

The Dublin City Pub INEX Legends feature saw Kevin Korsmo take his second win of the season after the frontrunners Cole O'Brien and Brody Willett tangled with just a couple remaining. Both drivers made the initial contact bringing out the caution and sending them to the rear. Three earlier spins kept the field tightly bunched throughout the race.

Austin Slabaugh earned his best run of the season finishing second while Danny Lehmkuhl was third.

In other Hy-Vee Racing Series action, Greg Hentrich led the early laps in Mountain Dew Sportsmen before surrendering the lead to point leader Dave McCalla on lap thirteen. Two laps later, McCalla dipped a little two low in turn two, hooked his tire on the apron and had to gather control of the car allowing Nathan Ballard to scoot by into the lead.

Ballard outran McCalla for the reminder of the race to earn his second win of the season in Sportsmen as well as his second feature win of the night. McCalla held on to second and Greg Hentrich was third.

Finally, in Carpetland USA Late Models presented by Performance Concepts, Caleb Adrian took no prisoners at the drop of the green flag and left the field quickly behind as earned his third win of the season. Adrian started in the second row and blasted by Tim Plummer and Brian Gibson to gain the lead and was never threatened during the 25-lap feature. The best battle on the track was for second as Gibson and Plummer swapped the position back and forth. Gibson prevailed for the second slot with Plummer holding third. John Spaw took fourth in a car normally driven by Brad Osborn.

Racing resumes next Friday night with Caseys General Stores. Hawkeye Downs Wall of Fame Night.
